



SAVE THE DATE

2 to 14 December 2018: COP 24 in Katowice, in Poland.



From 2 to 14 December Poland will host the 24th session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP24). For the Polish presidency of COP24, the main objective is the adoption of a package of measures, rules and tools (the « Katowice rules »), that will guarantee the concrete implementation of the Paris Agreement, and in particular by defining the path that each country must follow in order to speed up its efforts in terms of climate protection.

The ambition of the Polish Presidency is in fact to replace the ad hoc discussions and the fragmented objectives with a shared worldwide approach as regards the greenhouse gas emissions sectors (such as transport, energy, construction, agriculture), the absorption systems (forests, soils), the implementation measures (financing included) or again the measures for adapting the economies to the future changes.

At the same time COP24 will host two important events at the ministerial level:

- **the « third ministerial dialogue on climate finance »**, devoted to the assessment of the progress made in fulfilling the commitment of the developed countries to finding USD 100 billion by the year 2020 (financial framework for climate protection),
- **and the Talanoa dialogue »** - joint reflections on the way in which the parties should attain together all the objectives and targets of the Paris Agreement. On this occasion Poland will present its positive contribution to climate protection, emphasizing the magnitude, importance and effectiveness of the national policies, in particular in the fields of air quality, electromobility and the increasing of forest in resources.
