### « Release the energies in the Regions »

*10 proposals and 13 measures for concerted energy transition  
with the territories*



The Council of the Regions of France adopted on 22 May 2019 the « Release the energies in the Regions » contribution for concerted energy transition with the territories. The Regions put forward in it 10 proposals and 13 measures relating to the Multi-Annual Energy Programming project (PPE), the national Low Carbon Strategy project (SNBC), and in reaction to the amended climate and energy bill and the proposed energy and climate decree. This contribution follows on from the roadmap «For fair and efficient ecological transition through and with the Regions » adopted by the Council of the Regions on 27 March 2019.

The Council of the Regions of France asserts in this contribution:

- a local approach to energy programming;
- a clarification of the regional energy leader and the associated means;
- the support and rollout of local energy production sectors;
- the determining of the needs with the local players.

Among the flagship proposals in this contribution, we can mention:

- the improving of the regional (SRADDET) and national (PPE) energy planning in order to move towards a consolidated regional and national vision;
- the strengthening of the energy efficiency part of the PPE by securing and perpetuating the Housing Energy Performance Public Service (SPPEH);

- the local application and defining of a clear fiscal environmental framework for the actions of the Regions;
- the strong ambition to develop renewable energies with a high local added value. The Regions propose 6 concrete measures per sector including bio-energies, solar energy, methanation, hydrogen and marine energies) and a rate of installation consistent with economic and industrial developments.
- the defending of the specific nature of the ultra-maritime territories.
