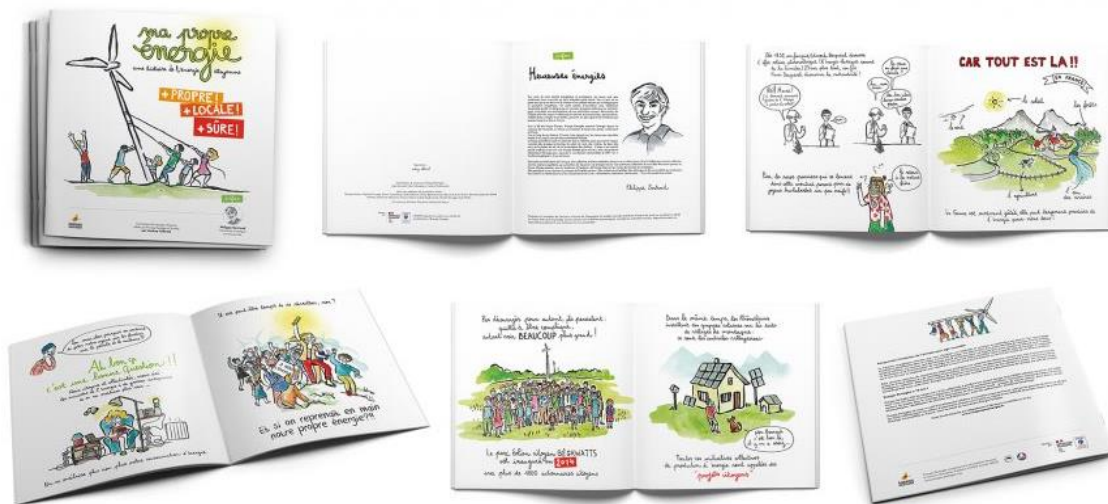

On the occasion of the 10th anniversary of the movement, Énergie Partagée is publishing a fuller version of the cartoon "My Own Energy", which was first published in 2015. Available online and in paper form, it tells the simple and inspiring story of energy to go into action!

Prefaced by Philippe Bertrand (Carnets de Campagne on France Inter), this new edition retraces the history of energy in an amusing way (from prehistory, via the oil crash or the centralization of French energy) and emphasizes the key steps that make up this culture we share around energy.

It also highlights the collective citizen initiatives which emerged at the beginning of this century and which are being developed today in all areas.
