“Investments in the future” programme: ADEME publishes its «Eco-efficient industry» assessment

At the end of June ADEME published the mapping of the companies that have won the calls for projects for the Investments in the Future Programme operated by ADEME in the Eco-efficient industry section.

In this assessment we get a panorama of the main innovations in the following industrial sectors:

- the recovery of residual heat for energy efficiency purposes
- the tools for the optimized management of energy
- breakthrough innovations for industrial processes in the glass, cement and iron and steel sectors

45 projects have been selected for funding since 2011. They group together 79 beneficiaries receiving direct help of €93 M out of a total project budget of €198 M.



Reminder

The aim of the Investments in the Future Programme (PIA), created by the French Government in 2010 and implemented by the General Secretariat for Investment, is to increase France's potential growth. ADEME is its operator for the innovations designed to speed up energy and environmental transition. Approximately 4 billion euros of funds have been allotted to it for the period 2010-2020 to finance innovative projects and develop tomorrow's industrial sectors. Since 2010 over 850 projects, of which 386 are owned by small and medium-sized businesses, have been given financial support amounting to 2.5 billion euros.
