ADEME is launching a call for contributions for the Energy Saving Certificates (ESC) Technical Days, which will take place in Paris on 5 and 6 December next.

FINAL DATE FOR SUBMITTING PROJECTS: 30 JUNE 2017

ADEME, in partnership with the Direction générale de l'énergie et du climat (DGEC) and the Association technique énergie et environnement (ATEE), organised a new edition of the Energy Saving Certificates (ESC) Technical Days, on 5 and 6 December 2017 at the Cité des Sciences in Paris.

These two days, which are intended for all the players involved in the energy consumption reduction dynamic - companies, local authorities, social landlords, specifiers, university dons, journalists or again international players, will be the opportunity to make an initial assessment of the 3rd period of the EEC scheme (2015-2017), find out the rules for the 4th period (2018-2020) and multiply the times for exchange between stakeholders.

On this account ADEME is launching a call for contributions open to all the EEC scheme players
In order to feed two types of exchange times:

- Proposals for testimonies from players for presentation at the sector workshops (construction, industry, transport, agriculture, local authorities)
- Ideas for subjects to be brought up at forums – format designed to facilitate exchanges, experience feedback and debates in small groups.
