1<sup>st</sup> edition of the global Climate Chance conference!



Launched on 2 December last within the Climate Generation Spaces of COP21\*, Climate Chance is set to become a regular global appointment for the non-state actors committed to fighting climate change. Local authorities, businesses, associations, unions, scientific bodies, citizens, are invited to attend this conference which should enable stock to be taken of the action worldwide, in-depth exchanges on both the successes and the difficulties, the promoting of the pooling of

Hosted by Nantes, the first edition of Climate Chance will be held from 26 to 28 September 2016 at the Nantes Congress Centre (La Cité) and should bring together several thousand participants from all over the globe.
